- 1. What is a particular lesson, activity, or unit you already use that you wish to incorporate sustainability?
- 2. What sustainability topic might it cover?
- 3. Backward Design: What is your end learning goal with this lesson?
- 4. What environmental, social, and economic issues will your lesson now cover?

5. How will your lesson address at least one of 5 key concepts: interconnectedness, scale (space and time), long-term development (future thinking), trade-offs, or collaboration?

6. How might you utilize the skills and knowledge of a subject area other than your own to help students understand the topic? (For example, if you are teaching about population growth in a math class, you might also work with social studies teachers to discuss social inequities in a world with a growing population.)
