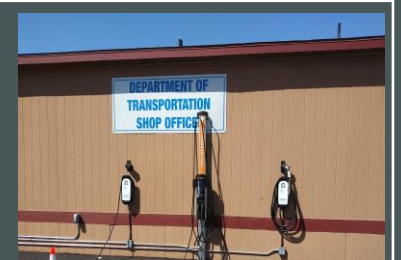
Current Projects



- Transit Vehicle EV Conversion
 - Partnered with
 - ZEVx (Zero Electric Vehicles, Inc)
 - SRP
 - ICF
 - ASU
 - Converting a 12 yr. old Transit vehicle with 193,000 to all electric operation
 - Adding 10 yrs. of usage to the Transit Vehicle
 - Save approximately \$7k in fuel Cost annually
 - GHG Reduction of 1,463 = 384 Trees Saved Annually

 - Installing necessary charging Infrastructure and Charging Devices
 - Establishing EV Training for Employees that reserve EV vehicles

 - 1 Tesla

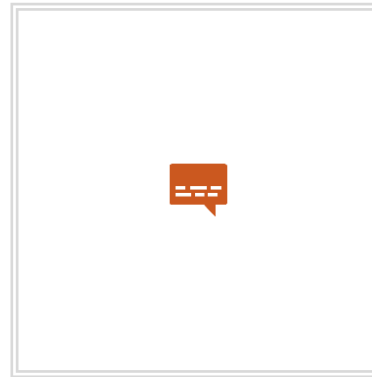

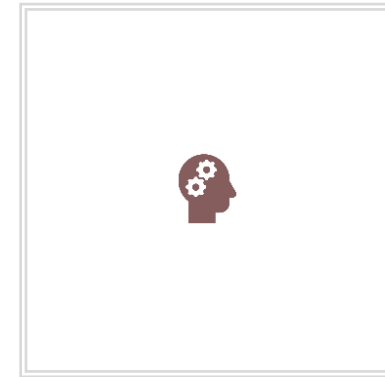
